- _____ 1. Brake lights are functional and visible.
- _____ 2. Windshield and windows are clear and have no cracks.
- _____ 3. Has rear and drivers side mirrors with no cracks.
- _____ 4. Gas cap tightens and seals.
- _____ 5. Body panels, spoilers, wings well secured.
- _____ 6. Tire to fender clearance sufficient, no rubbing.
- _____ 7. Corrosion is minimal and will not affect chassis strength
- _____ 8. Driver and passenger front windows come fully down.

SEATS AND SEAT BELTS/HARNESSES

- _____ 1. Driver and passenger seats are the same design and quality.
- _____ 2. Driver and passenger belts/harnesses are the same.
- _____ 3. Seats and belts are securely anchored metal to metal.
- _____ 4. Seat belts are not frayed on the edges or stretched.
- _____ 5. Race seats and harnesses are installed per manufacturers specs.

ENGINE COMPARTMENT

- _____ 1. No unusual or excessive oil leaks from the engine
- _____ 2. Fuel rails and lines are in good condition with no leaks
- _____ 3. Coolant hoses are in good shape with no leaks.
- _____ 4. Engine accessory belts are properly tensioned and in good shape

_____5. Throttle closes and opens without binding

BRAKES

- _____1. Rotors are in good condition and meet specs
- _____2. Calipers are firmly attached and show no signs of leakage.
- _____3. Pads have 70% or more of pad remaining.
- _____4. Brake fluid DOT 3 or better, brakes have been bled for this event.

SUSPENSION

- _____1. No excessive looseness in steering or suspension.
- _____2. No suspension pieces bent, excessively corroded or cracked
- _____3. Sway bars securely mounted with good drop links/hardware.
- _____4. Shock absorbers firm with no leaks.
- _____5. Axle bolts tight, boots not leaking or split, no excessive play.

TIRES AND WHEELS

- _____1. Tire has 40% or more of the original depth with even wear.
- _____2. Tire rating is H (130 mph) or better. (absolute minimum)
- _____3. Tires are free of cuts/cracks/repair plugs.
- _____4. Tires are no more than 5 years old.
- _____5. All tires are the same make and model....no mix and match.
- _____6. Wheels are free of cracks or bends.

EXHAUST SYSTEM

- _____1. All connections secure, all suspension points attached.
- _____2. No holes in any pipe or muffler.
- _____3. Corrosion is not excessive, heat shields securely connected.
