The participant is responsible for the safety of this participating vehicle. It is important you select a competent technician to inspect your vehicle. *The technician should check each item below that meets the standard as described.*

VEHICLE BODY/EXTERIOR

- 1. Brake lights are functional and visible.
- 2. Windshield and windows are clear and have no cracks.
- 3. Has rear and drivers side mirrors with no cracks.
- 4. Gas cap tightens and seals.
- 5. Body panels, spoilers, wings well secured.
- 6. Tire to fender clearance sufficient, no rubbing.
- 7. Corrosion is minimal and will not affect chassis strength.
- 8. Driver and passenger front windows come fully down or are non-glass.

SEATS AND SEAT BELTS/HARNESSES

- 1. Driver and passenger seats are the same design and quality.
- 2. Driver and passenger belts/harnesses are the same.
- 3. Seats and belts are securely anchored metal to metal.
- 4. Seat belts have not timed out, nor are they frayed or stretched.
- 5. Race seats and harnesses are installed per manufacturers specs.

ENGINE COMPARTMENT

- 1. No unusual or excessive oil leaks from the engine
- 2. Fuel rails and lines are in good condition with no leaks
- 3. Coolant hoses are in good shape with no leaks.
- 4. Engine accessory belts are properly tensioned and in good shape
- 5. Throttle closes and opens without binding

BRAKES

- 1. Rotors are in good condition and meet specs
- 2. Calipers are firmly attached and show no signs of leakage.

- 3. Pads have 70% or more of pad remaining.
- 4. Brake fluid DOT 3 or better, brakes have been bled for this event.

SUSPENSION

- 1. No excessive looseness in steering or suspension.
- 2. No suspension pieces bent, excessively corroded or cracked
- 3. Sway bars securely mounted with good drop links/hardware.
- 4. Shock absorbers firm with no leaks.
- 5. Axle bolts tight, boots not leaking or split, no excessive play.

TIRES AND WHEELS

- 1. Tires have 40% or more of the original depth with even wear.
- 2. Tires are all same make and model, and rated H (130 mph) or better.
- 3. Tires are less than 5 years old and free of cuts/cracks/repair plugs
- 4. Wheels are free of cracks or bends.

EXHAUST SYSTEM

- 1. All connections secure, all suspension points attached.
- 2. No holes in any pipe or muffler.
- 3. Corrosion is not excessive, heat shields securely connected
